Wanna Play In A Band — focusing on Rock Music.

A Rock Song for Children)

In this unit children will focus on the song 'I wanna play in a Band' by Joanna Mangona, a rock song for children. They will also listen to a range of different rock songs in lessons too such as We will rock you by queen'.

## **Background information**

In music children will explore the pulse and rhythm in music, playing games
In this song children will learn about singing and playing together in an ensemble. As well, as learn to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, they will listen and appraise classic rock songs.

## **Knowledge and Understanding**

In this unit pupils will learn...

- To listen and appraise, beginning to recognise the basic style of Rock music.
- To be able to find and move to the pulse.
- To be able to listen to the song and discuss the song and what can be heard in it.
- To be able to look for similarities and differences between songs.
- To be able to think about how the song is put together.
- To be able to perform and share a learnt song.
- To be able to compose with the song
