Word Wizards	New words will be posted regularly within this blog. Your challenge is to find out the meaning of the word and/or draw a picture to help us remember it. You could look up the word or ask an adult. Try and use the new word in a sentence.
5 Sentence Challenge	Each week I will post a picture and challenge you to write 5 sentences about it, you can write anything you like? Can you describe what is happening? What might you see, hear, smell or feel if you were there?
Debate Time	Each week I will post a new topic for debate, Willow Class love a good debate. Please share your thoughts and opinions. Your as important as anyone else and your views are valued!
Story Time	Sharing stories is a great way to come across new words. Willow class like reading stories together. We will regular post videos of us reading you a story. You can even record a video of you reading a story if you like?
Maths Zone	Regular maths challenges will be set here, things you can do around the home. We will also explore and discuss maths vocabulary.
Art and Design Zone	We are missing your brilliant artwork. Please share your creations. Maybe you could design a picture in 2paint or even a moving one in 2animate. Have you painted a picture or made a craft? You might have made something out of lego or even wood? We'd love to see, please upload a photo. We can then put these on our display board!
Joke Time	Just for fun, share some jokes with us and keep everyone smiling!

In addition to encouraging your child to engage with the class blogs, there will also be '2Dos' on Purple Mash. '2Dos' are games and activities that need to be carried out and saved. I will mark and comment on work submitted, so your child continues to receive feedback from us.

As all the children in Willow Class have highly individualised targets the 2Dos set on Purple Mash are also individualised and will focus around their IEP targets.
