# English:

#### LO: To plan a piece of extended writing.

Today, you will be planning to write a description of one of your favourite scenes from the book, Cloud Tea Monkeys. For example, you might plan to describe the scene when Tashi meets the monkeys in their usual place. Use a storyboard with 3 boxes (each to represent a separate paragraph):

- 1. Tashi hears the monkeys arrive in the plantation.
- 2. She follows them to their usual meeting place.
- 3. She shares her food with the monkeys and they groom her hair.



Now have a go at completing these calculations using column subtraction. If you are feeling really confident about column subtraction, complete the second set of calculations (Greater Depth).


