Science

We will be exploring space in the first half term with a focus on the components of the solar system, their orbit and the effects of the movement of the Earth. We move on to identifying forces such as gravity, friction and air resistance. We'll investigate that more than one force can act on an object and how mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.



Our maths learning this term will cover problem solving using all four operations, adding and subtracting fractions, mixed number and improper fractions, equivalent fractions and also comparing and ordering fractions. We will then move onto measure and explore area, perimeter, volume and 3D shapes. We will also continue with weekly times table activities.

P.E.

Our P.E lessons will cover gymnastics and invasion games, including sending, receiving, striking and travelling with a ball in a range of contexts.

Music

We will be continuing with our African Drumming!

Computing

We will continue to learn more about communicating information securely through an introduction to cryptography (the science of keeping communication and information secret). We will consider what makes a secure password and develop our understanding of online safety.



French

We will be learning some popular hobbies and talking about music.

Personal Development

Our Jigsaw topic this term is 'Dreams and Goals'. We will be identifying what we would like our lives to be like when we grow up and thinking about how we can set goals to achieve those dreams.

In our R.E. lessons we will continue to learn about both the Christian and Jewish faiths. We will be focussing on celebrations related to key figures including, Purim,
